CAMP LEADERS

Camp leaders are the engine of all volunteering projects. They connect the volunteers to the local community and coordinate the work to be done.

- Support volunteers in their learning process
- Create a safe space for all participants
- Connect local communities with international volunteers

HOSTS AND COMMUNITIES

Local hosts are the key actors from the local communities aiming to make the change happen. They identify the needs from the local community and provide accommodation, food and logistical support to the volunteers who then can contribute to fulfill the aim of the volunteer projects.
